The Department of Sociology at the University of Haifa (Israel) invites applications for a tenure-track position at any rank beginning in Fall 2022.

Qualifications: Ph.D. in Sociology or a closely related Social Science discipline by the time of employment; a strong record of research and publications in peer-reviewed academic journals.

We seek job candidates in one of the following broad areas of research: Political Sociology; Social Stratification and Inequality; Economic Sociology [including Digital Society and Economy]; Sociology of Consumption, Health and Sustainability.

In each of these four areas, research employing Computational Sociology [quantitative or qualitative], is an advantage.

Applicants should send:

1. Cover letter describing current and future research plans and teaching interests.
2. Curriculum vitae (including list of publications and teaching experience).
3. Electronic copies of published articles and book chapters.
4. Names and contact details of three potential writers of recommendation letters including one from the Ph.D. Advisor and Post-Doctorate Host, when applicable.

The job includes teaching in Hebrew, with a period of three years for acquiring the language. The job also includes supervising graduate students working on their M.A. and Ph.D. projects.
