



Position Opening: The Department of Sociology and Anthropology, Ben Gurion University of the Negev

The Department of Sociology and Anthropology at Ben Gurion University of the Negev (Israel) invites applicants holding a Ph.D. degree in Sociology or Anthropology (by July 2018), for a position at the rank of Lecturer or Senior Lecturer, by means of competitive fellowships. Candidates are expected to have strong research abilities as demonstrated by their publications in order to qualify for Vatav fellowships (Alon and Maof) and Azrieli fellowship. Postdoctoral experience is advantageous. Candidates must be able to teach in Hebrew. The appointment is pending on winning a fellowship and on institutional approval.

Applications should include the following: a cover letter describing current and future research plans and teaching interests, a CV and list of publications, samples of published work, the names and contact information of three referees.
