



Postdoctoral Applications: Distributional Workplace Accounts European Research Council (ERC) Research Project Call for Applications 2023-2024

Qualified candidates in sociology, economics, political science, labor relations and related fields are invited to apply for a three-year postdoctoral research position. The postdoctoral fellow will join an ERC-funded research project on the role of workers' and employers' bargaining power in "Distributional Workplace Accounts" under the supervision of Prof. Tali Kristal. The postdoctoral fellow will also be encouraged to develop their independent research agenda in related areas.

The fellowship carries an annual stipend in the amount of 120,000 NIS. The successful candidate is expected to start by September 2023, or shortly thereafter.

The application deadline is April 15, 2023.
Interviews will be held in late April 2023.

Required skills and qualifications:

- Ph.D. in sociology, economics, political science, labor relations, or related fields. Candidates must show proof of submitting their doctoral dissertation before the start date.
- Excellent academic background and interest in income inequality and labor market dynamics.
- Competence and experience in research on social and economic inequality, using advanced statistical data analysis techniques for longitudinal/multilevel data.
- Ability to lead independent research and to work as part of a team.
- Candidates must have received their Ph.D. degree within the last four years.

Applications should include the following materials:

- Research statement (2-3 pages) describing your doctoral dissertation and future research plans. Please elaborate on your experience using advanced techniques of statistical data analysis.
- Detailed CV including a list of publications.
- Writing sample (one published article or unpublished dissertation chapter).
- Letter of recommendation sent directly from your doctoral supervisor.
